

WORDS OF CONSECRATION

On the night of His betrayal, Jesus took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying: *“Take, eat, this is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me”*.

In like manner, after supper He took the cup. And when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying: *“Drink of this, for this is My blood of the New Covenant which is shed for you and for many, for remission of sins; do this as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me”*.
